### Window Wonder



#### Ingredients:

One and a half cups of warm clean water, one and a half tablespoons of white vinegar and three drops of peppermint essential oil.

#### How to use:

- ❖ You will need two clean cloths, one to wipe on and one to wipe off. Maybe use a clean old tea towel or t-shirt?
- ❖ Apply about one teaspoon of your Window Wonder mixture to one of the cloths.
- ❖ Keep any remaining Window Wonder in a sealed container. You may want to design and draw a label for it.
- ❖ Rub the window, you may need to add some elbow grease! If you don't know where to find this, ask someone to show you where you can get it.
- ❖ Leave the window to dry then use the other cloth to 'buff' or polish the window and remove the Window Wonder cleaner. You may need to get some more elbow grease for this.
- ❖ Stand back and admire the view!
- ❖ As delicious as your Window Wonder cleaner might smell, do not drink it or rub it onto your skin. This mixture is for use on grimy windows only.
